Spring was in the air for a few minutes again today and in-between bouts of hail my thoughts turned once again to rallies and road trips, new adventures and old friends as we head into a new year of activities. It's been a long two years with nearly no activity and very little contact with fellow Bus Nuts but this promises to be a year of turnabout. We have a full schedule of rallies, May through October, lots of new faces on the governing board, and nearly a dozen recent new members.

Many changes have evolved in the way RV parks do business as a result of pandemic pressures. Millions of people have moved into their RVs and as a result most venues now have designated permanent, long-term and short-term sites in addition to overnight. Those permanent and long-term sites were taken from short -term and overnight sites. So, finding a venue with 18 to 24 sites available is nearly impossible these days. That's why on your signup sheets you will see that we have a limited number of sites available. Also, we are seeing RV parks asking to have reservations confirmed and to be paid for earlier than in previous years. Newport required that reservations be confirmed and paid for 9 months in advance. Because a lot of homeless people are living in very old and unkempt RVs, some venues require pictures of any RV older than a certain age. Nearly all of our coaches will require pictures at the Westfir rally. A pain, but the new norm. If you travel with your coach, you will experience this frequently. I keep 4 pictures of my coach on my phone just for this purpose.

We have no hosts assigned for any of the scheduled rallies except for Newport. Please consider hosting or co-hosting a rally. Feel free to contact me directly if you have questions or concerns about hosting. It's not as difficult as you might think and in general there is a lot of help available. So, expect things to be a bit different, read the signup instructions carefully, follow the directions to a T and let's get back to enjoying the reason we have these coaches!
