Dear Caravan Leader:

To ensure your caravan's safe and timely arrival at the upcoming 2024 Redmond, OR Convention, please read and adhere to the following information that will assist FMCA in parking your caravan RVs:

- The Caravan leader is responsible for assuring that <u>ALL</u> caravan RVs are <u>PRE-REGISTERED</u> for the event.
- <u>Make sure all RVs in your caravan have the same parking.</u> For example, everyone gets 30 amp or 50 amp electricity, or everyone is in general parking, etc. The parking team will do its best to keep you all together.
- The Caravan leader is encouraged to pick up Will Call confirmation packets for registered caravan RVs at the Welcome Area before arrival. Will Call hours at the arrival area will be from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. beginning Saturday, August 10. **Note:** FMCA's parking credential **and** caravan card **must** be prominently displayed inside on the front windshield of each RV, per instructions on the reverse side of the card.
- Whenever possible, tow cars should be disconnected and driven separately into your permanent parking area.
- Members of your caravan who have registered for special parking, such as disabled members, need to be placed together at the end of the caravan. Trailers and 5th Wheels should lead the caravan.
- The Caravan leader is **required** to have a cell phone.

An accurate final RV count must be communicated via phone/TEXT at 513-256-5779 OR by email (convention@fmca.com) to FMCA no less than 24 hours before arrival at the convention site.
