DIRECTIONS to HOOD RIVER COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

3020 WyEast Rd, Hood River, OR 97031

This is the route the fruit trucks use. It avoids steep grades; hairpin turns and narrow roads. You may not be happy if you use another.

From I-84 Eastbound or Westbound take exit 64. EASTBOUND turn RIGHT, WESTBOUND turn LEFT to BUTTON BRIDGE ROAD. (US Hwy 35 South)

NOTE: While on US Hwy 35 South your GPS may tell you to turn on DETHMAN RIDGE DRIVE or EHRCK HILL ROAD. DO NOT DO THIS. Narrow roads, hairpin turns and very steep grades await you on these routes.

Go 6.5 miles on Hwy 35 South. Sign ODEL RIGHT $^{1}\!\!/_{4}$ MILE / JCT 282

In ¼ mile turn RIGHT at signs ODEL 1 / SOUTH 35 / WEST 281 (There will be a right turn lane for this turn. This is Davis Drive but there is no sign)

Go 0.7 miles. Turn RIGHT at Signs FAIRGROUNDS / WEST 282 (Odel Hwy)

In 0.3 miles Hwy curves left, then in 900 feet curve hard RIGHT as traffic merges from left. DO NOT GO STRAIGHT AHEAD

Go 0.4 miles. Turn LEFT on SUMMIT DRIVE

Go 0.5 miles. Turn RIGHT on WyEast Rd. Sign "Welcome to Hood River County Fairgrounds" on corner

In 400 feet turn LEFT into GATE A.
Pull forward to first intersection, unhook and wait to be parked
